Planner:

We will be providing our 6th graders with planners this year to help teach them these skills so that they may choose a planner of their own in coming years.

Organizational System:

It is important that our middle school students begin thinking about the best way to keep themselves organized in school. Students will have 8 subjects this year: Ivrit, Jewish Life, Language Arts, Math, Mishna, Science, Social Studies, and Tanach. We recommend the following organizational system for all of our 6th graders and will work with them throughout the year to help them reflect upon what will work best for each of them as individuals in the coming years.

Notebooks and Folders

With this method, students take notes in notebooks and organize papers in separate folders for each subject. We recommend matching the color of notebooks and folders for each subject. (For example, the science composition notebook and science folder might both be green.) Please note that any subjects that have specific requirements are listed, as well.

Planner (8th Grade Only):
 It is important that our middle school students begin thinking about the best way to keep track of nightly homework, long-term assignments and projects, upcoming tests and quizzes, and more. Our 8th graders should spend some time before school looking for a planner that will work for them. We recommend that all planners have ample space to write down daily homework from 8 subjects, as well as a month-at-a-glance page that students may use to plan for long-term assignments, tests, quizzes, etc. Please take time with your child to find a planner that will suit him/her for the coming school year. **The school will be providing 7th graders with a planner. If your 7th grader would prefer his/her own non-school provided planner, you may follow the guidelines above to do select one that you feel is appropriate.**

Organizational System:
 It is important that our middle school students begin thinking about the best way to keep themselves organized in school. We understand that a single method will not necessarily work for every student. Please speak with your child about what s/he feels will be most comfortable for him/her to navigate as s/he transitions between period throughout the day, as well as when going to and from home. Students will have 8 subjects this year: Gemara, Ivrit, Jewish Life, Language Arts, Math, Science, Social Studies, and Tanach. We recommend that students choose one of the following options or something similar to keep notes and handouts organized.

Option 1: Notebooks and Folders
 With this method, students take notes in notebooks and organize papers in separate folders for each subject. We recommend matching the color of notebooks and folders for each subject. Please note that any subjects that have specific requirements are listed, as well.
