

Planner:

It is important that our middle school students begin thinking about the best way to keep track of nightly homework, longterm assignments and projects, upcoming tests and quizzes, and more. We will be providing our 6th graders with planners this year to help teach them these skills so that they may choose a planner of their own in coming years.

Organizational System:

It is important that our middle school students begin thinking about the best way to keep themselves organized in school. Students will have 8 subjects this year: Ivrit, Jewish Life, Language Arts, Math, Mishna, Science, Social Studies, and Tanach. We recommend the following organizational system for all of our 6th graders and will work with them throughout the year to help them reflect upon what will work best for each of them as individuals in the coming years.

Notebooks and Folders

With this method, students take notes in notebooks and organize papers in separate folders for each subject. We recommend matching the color of notebooks and folders for each subject. (For example, the science composition notebook and science folder might both be green.) Please note that any subjects that have specific requirements are listed, as well.
